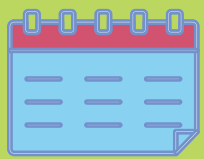
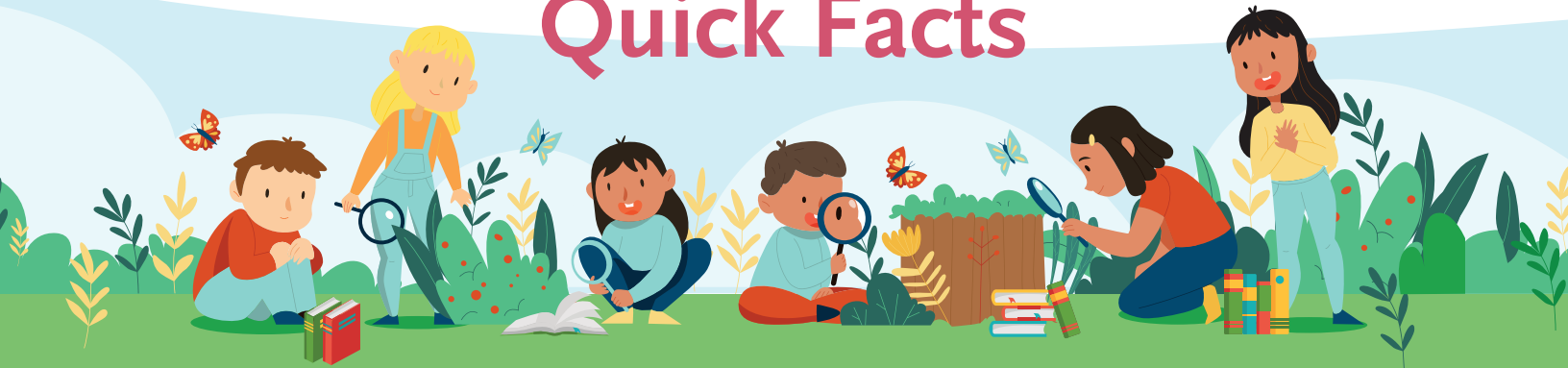


Summer Learning Loss

Quick Facts

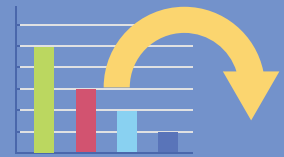


5-6 weeks

Student achievement scores drop by
one month

of school-year learning during summer vacation.



Frequent **targets of summer learning loss** include

$$25 \div 5 \quad 7 \times 6 \\ \frac{4}{5} + \frac{3}{5}$$

math facts, decoding and phonics.
