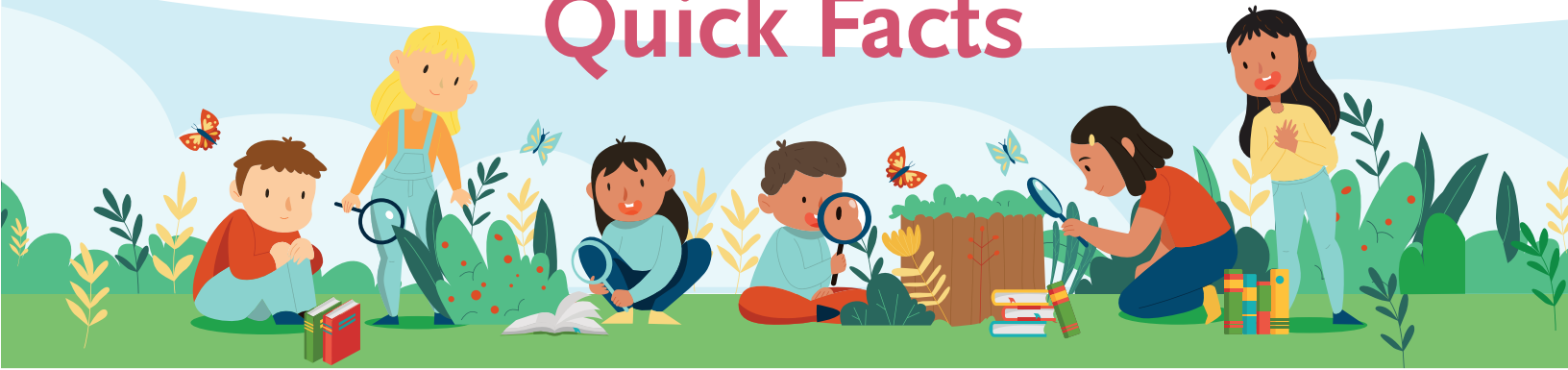
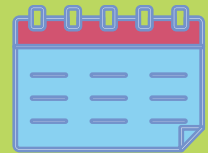


# Summer Learning Loss

Student achievement scores

drop by **one month**

during summer vacation.

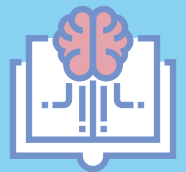


Frequent **targets of learning loss**

include knowledge that requires repeated practice, including **math facts, decoding and phonics.**

Students need **access** to reading materials over the summer, but also

explicit instruction in **comprehension and fluency skills.**
